Conductor, composer and arranger Howard Cable has been a leading figure in the musical life of Canada ever since coming into prominence with CBC radio and television. On Broadway he arranged for Richard Rodgers and Meredith Willson and is a chief arranger for the Canadian Brass and the Elmer Iseler Singers. He has conducted for the National Ballet, the Banff, Shaw and Charlottetown Festivals, and many of Canada's orchestras and bands.
