### Harvey Gleiser

Harvey is well known to our audiences as a frequent soloist and one of the Winds original members. After early instruction from George Ziegler and William Gallagher, he performed with the Kitchener Musical Society Band and took numerous solo awards in festivals across Ontario. During WWII Harvey was a member and soloist with the prestigious RCAF Central Band and later studied music and conducting at Wayne State University, Tanglewood and Eastman. In addition to serving as player and assistant conductor in the K-W Symphony, Harvey performed with and directed the Twin City Operatic Society, and directed his own concert orchestra.
