He is very active as an arranger, a recent work being played by the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra in London, England.

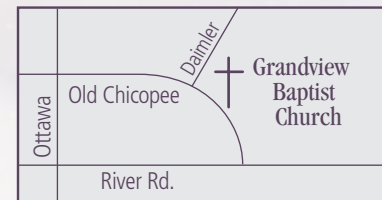

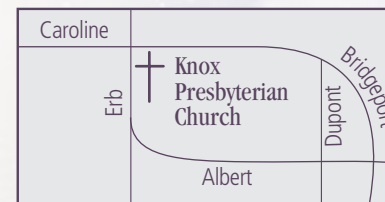
