Alfred began his music lessons at an early age in Hong Kong. He completed his Bachelor of Music at Wilfrid Laurier University and then his Master of Music from The University of Western Ontario where he studied and taught with Maestro Jerome Summers. Alfred has served as Music Director of the Pembroke Symphony and the Ottawa Chamber Orchestra and has conducted the Kanata Symphony Orchestra and the Davenport Chamber Orchestra. In 2002 he was invited to Hong Kong to direct the Ling Liang Church Orchestra to perform in Austria and Germany and the Alumni Symphonic Band in Guangzhou, China. At present Alfred is teaching and freelance conducting in the Toronto area.
