

Started in 1998, the **Grand Philharmonic Youth Choir** includes singers in high school and up to the age of 23. At our regular rehearsals, we provide our young singers with music education that includes voice production, theory, music literacy and ear training. Singers perform in their own concerts, with other organizations, and make recordings.

The choir has a long tradition of choral excellence including a first-place win during the CBC Choir competition in 2006, and several European tours. In 2012, the choir travelled to Vienna to win first place in the Mixed Choirs division of the International Summa Cum Laude Festival.
